You have to choose at least 1!

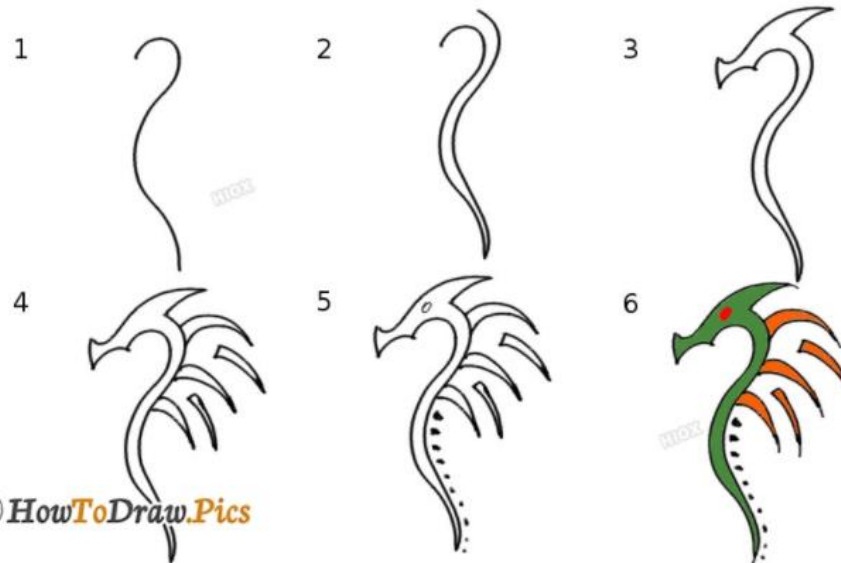
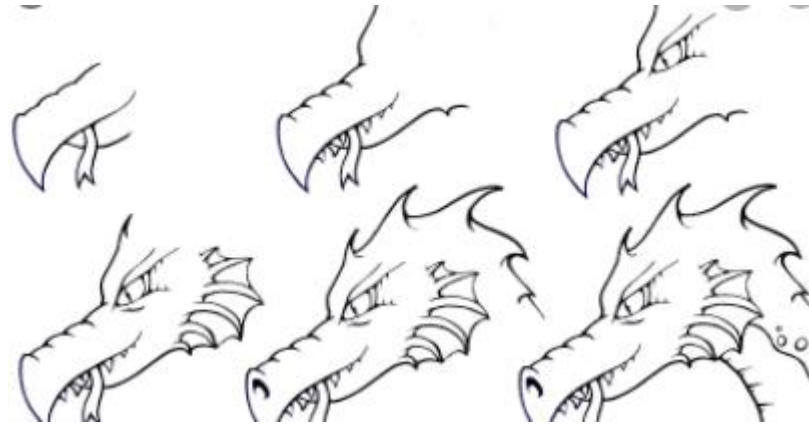
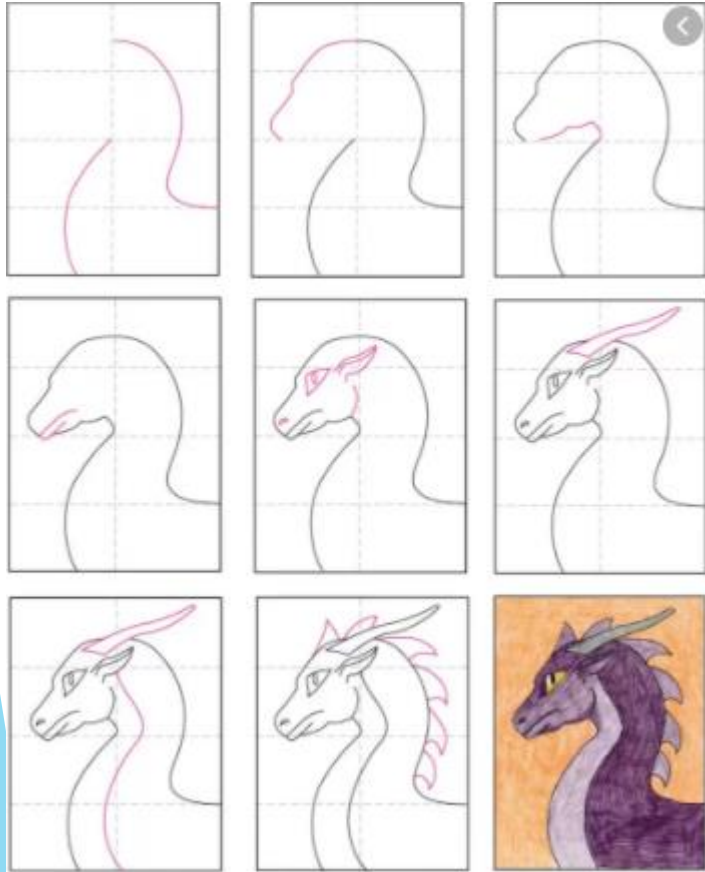
### Activity 1

Watch the YouTube video link (below) on how to draw a dragon and have a go. Use pencils, black pens or paints.

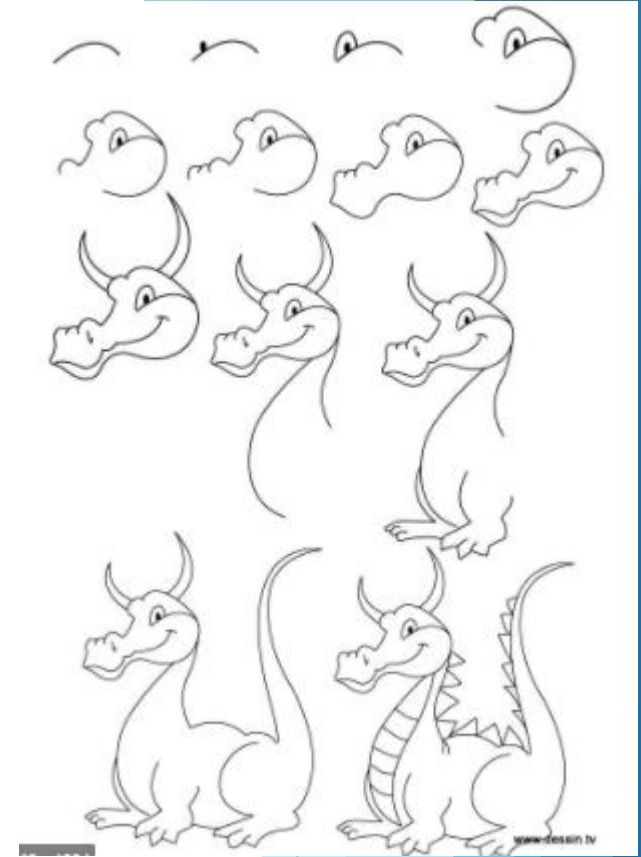

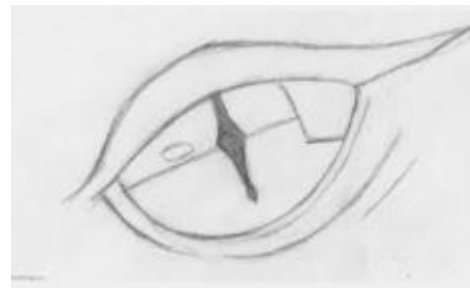
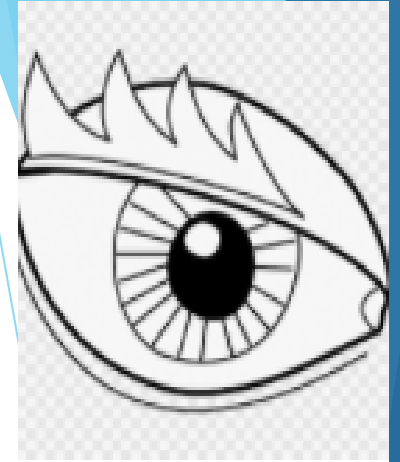
### Activity 3
