- ▶ Plan lessons that will be fun and exciting and will challenge you to think lots
- ▶ Use the recognition boards in your classrooms to celebrate when you are showing that you are being ready, respectful and safe

How will staff celebrate if you show that you are ready, respectful and safe?

- ▶ Recognition boards
- ▶ Weekly certificate awarded to 2 children in each class
- ▶ House points (Do-Jo's) - collected and winning house team members attend a Mad Hatter's tea party in the Summer term with Dr Carr & SLT
- ▶ Postcards home to share with your family how ready, respectful and safe you have been
- ▶ 'Always Friday' (once COVID restrictions lift!) - a hot chocolate with either Dr Carr, Mrs Liversey, Mrs Dutton, Miss Tyrer, Mrs Ahmad or Mrs Williams - to celebrate the children who 'always' show they are ready, respectful and safe



Recognition boards!

- ▶ Each week, the whole school will have a focus on a key behaviour and any children showing the focus behaviour can be placed on the recognition board!
- ▶ It is not just the staff who can suggest who goes on the recognition board...
