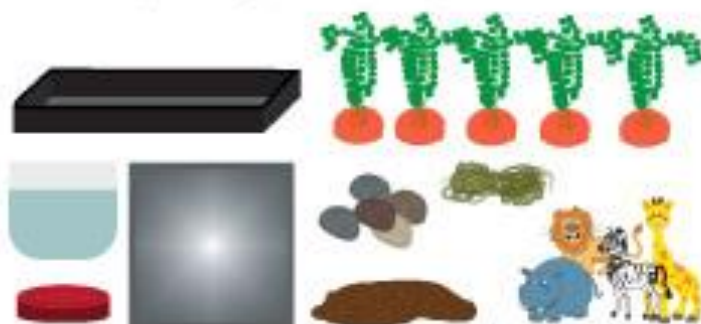


A Carrot top Jungle



You will need

A large shallow container; as many carrot tops as possible; water; a small lid from a meat paste or baby food jar; 10cm by 10cm pieces of tinfoil (1 for each carrot top); soil; small stones; pieces of moss; small plastic wild animals.



What you do

Take a piece of tinfoil and press it tightly round the bottom and sides of the small lid. Remove the lid gently leaving a shallow mould of tinfoil. Repeat this until all the tinfoil has been used up. Fill the shallow container with soil and carefully press the tinfoil moulds into the soil. Put the small stones and moss around the moulds. Fill the moulds with a little water and put a carrot top in each one. Keep the carrot tops watered and the soil damp and after a few days the carrots will sprout green leaves. (Ensure that the children don't eat the leaves). Place your wild animals in your jungle.
