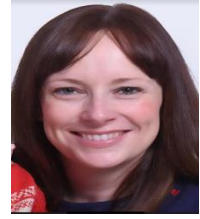




Woodlands Primary School HLTA's

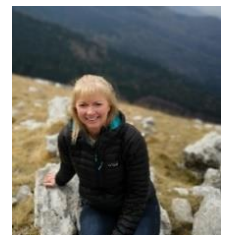
